**Rededication of Memorial and Act of Remembrance,  
Sunday 8 November**

As reported in November's Village News, 2020 is the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the dedication of our parish's Memorial Cross.

Due to changed restrictions, there will be no church services until further notice, although your church will remain open for you. However, there will be a brief, outdoor service of re-dedication of our Memorial, including a few prayers from the original Service of Dedication in 1920. We will then have our normal Act of Remembrance around the Memorial, including the reading of the Names of our Fallen and placing of wreaths.

The Rededication and Remembrance will start at 10:40am and end at 11:10am this Sunday, 8 November.

There is adequate space in the Churchyard and Church Street to enable compliance with the new restrictions. So, once again, I call parishioners to come and remember our sacred Fallen.
